

Amendments concerning Face Coverings

Appendix 2 (Risk Assessment)

A new section has been inserted to cover the current government guidance regarding face coverings in Community Facilities:

6. Face Coverings

All users of the village hall, on entering the building and for the duration of their visit, must wear a face covering, unless one of the following exemptions apply:

1. Under 12 years of age
2. Undertaking physical activity such as dancing, exercise class etc.
3. Giving a group presentation or talk
4. Eating/drinking
5. Have a qualifying exemption on medical grounds.

Exemptions 2,3 & 4 only apply during the specified circumstances

Appendix 3 (Responsibilities)

In line with the above, there is now an additional responsibility about face coverings for users of the Hall.

Hirers (and any other users) MUST:

Ensure that all their clients, on entering the building and for the duration of their visit, wear a face covering, unless one of the following exemptions apply:

1. Under 12 years of age
2. Undertaking physical activity such as dancing, exercise class etc.
3. Giving a group presentation or talk.
4. Eating/drinking
5. Have a qualifying exemption on medical grounds.

Exemptions 2,3 & 4 only apply during the specified circumstances
